The Government of Sindh has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of Sindh Enhancing Response to reduce Stunting Project (SERRSP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include services for management information system for design, development, implementation and grievances redressal mechanism for Conditional Cash Transfers (CCT), Social Protection Strategy Unit (SPSU) which will support the systemization of the information, integration with existing information mechanisms and processes for the nutrition CCT program. To this end, the Government of Sindh is collaborating with the World Bank in the piloting of a Health and Nutrition Conditional Cash Transfer (H&N CCT) program in the districts of Tharparkar and Umarkot.

The Social Protection Strategy Unit, Chief Minister’s Secretariat, Government of Sindh now invites consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experiences to perform the Services.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section-III Paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank’s Procurement Regulations for Borrowers July, 2016.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

The selection process will be carried out following **Consultant Qualification Selection (CQS)** in accordance with Paragraph 7.6 of World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (July 2016).
