The Government of Sindh has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of Sindh Enhancing Response to reduce Stunting Project (SERRSP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The main objective of this Assignment is to conduct appropriate assessment of all processes and mechanisms through a well-placed Monitoring and Evaluation, spot checks and process evaluation system. Spot checks and process evaluation during implementation will be integral part of the pilot programme and would be used to provide regular, timely and reliable quantitative and qualitative feedback to the SPSU on the efficiency and effectiveness of the programme processes and recommend, where necessary, corrective measures to improve the programme design and implementation mechanisms during the assignment period.

The selected Monitoring and Evaluation, spot checks and process evaluation firm would need to develop a comprehensive understanding of the programme by referring to the Operations Manual and through discussions and meetings with SPSU team.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy.

Interested firms are requested to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) at the address mentioned below.

The interested consultancy firm shall be shortlisted in accordance with the following criteria:

- Firm should be registered in FBR (NTN & SRB) as an active filer.
- Experience in conducting large scale surveys, including but not limited to spot checks and process evaluation on Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs)/Computer Aided Personal Interviews (CAPI).
- Experience in poverty survey work and spot checks, process evaluation and impact evaluation conducted on cash transfers would be given preference.
- Proven ability to work with local partners, authorities and communities.
